## October 9: "In the Name of the Family"

Not sanctioned by Islam, "honor killings" are a brutal remnant of ancient tribal notions of loyalty and shame. This film examines those instances when Muslim women living in North America have been victims of murder at the hands of male family members.

## October 16: "Trust"

This film exposes the danger of online relationships when a young girl develops a friendship with a predator she meets in a chat room and is subsequently assaulted by him. It is a shocking revelation of how predators use online resources to groom and lure victims—a must see for young women and parents.

## October 23: "Sin by Silence"

Documents the lives of women who chose to fight back against their abusers and by doing so wound up in prison. These women then worked to educate the system about the silent and systemic nature of domestic violence by forming the first inmate-initiated action group-- Convicted Women Against Abuse.
